ORDER AMENDING ORDER

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 285-D

In DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 285-A (Order 285-A), issued March 31, 1989, the Department of Energy (DOE) authorized BC Gas Inc., to import Canadian natural gas to be stored in the State of Washington and to export the stored gas back to Canada. See 1 FE Para. 70,206. On July 26, 1991, the prior order was amended by DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 285-B (Order 285-B) which granted authorization through April 30, 1996, to import for storage and subsequently export up to 3,180,243 Mcf of gas annually at Sumas, Washington. See 1 FE Para. 70,467. DOE was informed on June 16, 1993, that the firm will become BC Gas Utility Ltd., beginning July 1, 1993. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order Nos. 285-A and 285-B are amended to reflect the corporate name change by substituting BC Gas Utility Ltd., for BC Gas Inc., as the importer and exporter of the gas, effective
