## ERRATA NOTICE

On March 28, 1994, the Department of Energy issued DOE/FE
Order No. 929 (Order 929) granting Brooklyn Navy Yard
Cogeneration Partners, L.P. authorization to import up to 10,000
MMBtu per day of Canadian natural gas from Crestar Energy and up
to 15,000 MMBtu per day from PanCanadian Petroleum Limited for a
15-year term beginning on November 1, 1995. Order 929 did not
authorize the additional amount requested by the Applicant to
cover the transportation fuel and lost and unaccounted for gas
requirements of the domestic pipeline systems which would deliver
the imported volumes from the international border near
Waddington, New York, to New York City. Accordingly, Ordering
Paragraph (A) of Order 929 is amended to include authorization to
import up to an additional 508 MMBtu per day of natural gas for
transportation and line loss.
