ORDER TERMINATING LONG-TERM AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 216-B

ANR Pipeline Company (ANR) is currently authorized to import up to 75,000 Mcf per day of natural gas from Canada until October 31, 1994, pursuant to DOE/ERA Opinion and Order No. 216 (Order 216),1/ issued January 22, 1988. This gas was to be imported pursuant to a gas sales agreement between ANR and ProGas Limited (ProGas) dated May 17, 1979, as amended. On July 29, 1994, ANR notified the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE), under 10 C.F.R. 590.407 of DOE's regulations, that the gas sales agreement was terminated by the parties effective March 31, 1994, and that ProGas is no longer selling gas to ANR under this authorization.

Accordingly, because there is no longer any need for this
