ORDER AMENDING AUTHORIZATION
TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 439-A

Under DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 332,1/ issued
September 12, 1989, as amended by DOE/FE Opinion and Order No.
439 (Order 439),2/ issued October 24, 1990, the Office of
Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy granted ICG Utilities
(Ontario) Ltd. ("ICG Ontario") authorization to import from
Canada up to 10,220 MMcf of natural gas per year, and to
subsequently export the same gas back to Canada over a term of 15
years beginning November 1, 1990, through October 31, 2005. Some
of this gas is sold in Canada to the company's gas distribution
customers, but most of it is used to fuel an electric
cogeneration plant at Fort Frances, Ontario.

On August 5, 1994, an application was filed with the Office
of Fossil Energy to amend Order 439 to reflect that ICG Ontario

had changed its name to Centra Gas Ontario Inc. effective January 21, 1991, as the result of the purchase of ICG Ontario by Westcoast Energy, Inc., a Vancouver-based Canadian energy company. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 439 is amended by substituting Centra Gas Ontario Inc. as the importer and exporter of the natural gas.
