ORDER TERMINATING AUTHORIZATIONS TO IMPORT AND EXPORT NATURAL GAS

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 467-B

On February 28, 1990, Goetz Energy Corporation (Goetz), a natural gas marketer, was authorized in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 467-A (Order 467-A) to export to Canada up to 25,000 Mcf per day of domestic natural gas and to import the same gas back into the United States for a period of 15 years ending October 31, 2008.1/ This authorization was granted as part of a transportation arrangement to aid Goetz in supplying its customers in New York State. In addition, Goetz was granted blanket authorization in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 658 (Order 658), issued August 6, 1992, to import up to 140 Bcf of Canadian natural gas for a two-year period which expires November 24, 1994.2/

In a letter dated October 25, 1994, Goetz informed the Department of Energy (DOE) that it sold the natural gas segment

of its business on April 1, 1994. Thus, there is no longer any need for Goetz to hold the two import/export authorizations granted by DOE. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import and export natural gas granted in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 467-A (FE Docket No. 90-74-NG) and the authorization to import natural gas granted in DOE/FE Opinion and Order No. 658 (FE Docket No. 92-63-NG) are hereby terminated.
