## ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 883-B

BridgeGas Company, as successor to BridgeGas U.S.A. Inc., is currently authorized to import up to 50 Bcf of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on the date of first import delivery after January 31, 1994. Imports of natural gas under this authorization commenced February 14, 1994, and the two-year term, therefore, extends through February 13, 1996. These imports were originally authorized in DOE/FE Order No. 8831/

(Order 883), issued November 29, 1993, as amended by DOE/FE Order No. 883-A2/ (Order 883-A), issued May 3, 1994.

On August 22, 1994, Teco Gas Marketing Company (Teco) filed a second application to further amend Order 883 to reflect the change in company name as a result of the acquisition of BridgeGas U.S.A. Inc. by Teco Pipeline Company (Teco Pipeline) on February 1, 1994. Teco is a wholly-owned subsidiary of Teco

Pipeline. Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the import authorization conferred by DOE/FE Order Nos. 883 and 883-A is again amended by substituting Teco Gas Marketing Company for BridgeGas Company as the importer of the natural gas.
