## ORDER TRANSFERRING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 165-A

On March 13, 1987, the Economic Regulatory Administration (ERA) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted Fiscus Inc. (Fiscus) authorization in DOE/ERA Opinion and Order No. 165 <sup>1/2</sup> (Order 165), to import up to 250 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on the date of first delivery. The ERA was the predecessor to the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) in approving import/export authorizations. Imports under Order 165 have not yet begun.

On June 25, 1999, Fiscus and Medpath Energy Corp. (Medpath), an affiliate of Fiscus, jointly filed an application with DOE/FE, under section 3 of the Natural Gas Act (NGA)<sup>2/</sup> and DOE Delegation Order Nos. 0204-111 and 0204-127, requesting the transfer of Fiscus' import

authority to Medpath. Fiscus and Medpath are Nevada and Alberta corporations respectively, sharing a common address in Calgary, Alberta.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the NGA, the import authorization conferred by DOE/ERA Opinion and Order No. 165 is transferred from Fiscus to Medpath effective the date of this Order. Medpath shall be bound by all terms and conditions set forth in Order 165.
