## ORDER VACATING NATURAL GAS IMPORT AUTHORIZATION

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 492-B

On March 28, 1991, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted long-term authorization to Fulton Cogeneration Associates (Fulton) in DOE/FE Order No. 492 (Order 492) (1 FE ¶ 70,435) to import up to 55 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a 15 year period beginning on the date of first delivery and ending on October 31, 2005.

On March 26, 1999, DOE received a letter dated March 21, 1999, from Coastal, the managing partner for Fulton, stating that as of February 1, 1999, Order 492 should be terminated as Fulton will no longer be importing gas from Canada.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, the authorization to import natural gas granted by Order 492 is hereby vacated.
