## ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 1542-A

On November 23, 1999, the Department of Energy (DOE) granted Amoco Energy Trading Corporation (Amoco) in DOE/FE Order No. 1542 (Order1542) 2 FE ¶ 70,414, authority to import up to 600 billion cubic feet of liquefied natural gas (LNG) over a two-year term beginning on the date of first delivery. Deliveries of LNG under this authorization began on August 22, 2000, therefore the term of the authorization extends through August 21, 2002.

On October 11, 2000, the Office of Fossil Energy of DOE was notified that Amoco's name had been changed to BP Energy Company.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 1542 is amended to substitute BP Energy Company for Amoco Energy Trading Corporation as the importer and exporter of natural gas. All terms and conditions in Order 1542 remain in full force and effect.
