## ORDER AMENDING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA

## DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2229-A

On July 21, 2006, the Office of Fossil Energy of the Department of Energy granted blanket authorization to Avista Energy, Inc. (Avista) in DOE/FE Order No. 2229 (Order 2229) to export natural gas to Canada.

On the cover sheet of Order 2229, in the Order authorization paragraph, the country authorization was inadvertently listed as Mexico, and should have been listed as Canada. Additionally, Subparagraph A of the Order paragraph inadvertently stated the term of authority began on July 3, 2006 and extends through July 2, 2008, and should have stated the term of authority began on May 1, 2006 and extends through April 30, 2008.

Accordingly, pursuant to section 3 of the Natural Gas Act, Order 2229 is amended as follows:

a. The Order authorization paragraph on the cover sheet is amended to read, "ORDER GRANTING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO EXPORT NATURAL GAS TO CANADA."
b. Subparagraph A of the Order paragraph is amended to read, "Avista Energy, Inc. (Avista) is

authorized to export up to a combined total of 219 billion cubic feet (Bcf) of natural gas to

Canada. The two-year term of authority began on May 1, 2006 and extends through April 30, 2008."

- c. Subparagraph C of the Order paragraph is amended to read, "The first monthly report required by this Order is due not later than August 30, 2006, and should cover the reporting period of July, 2006."
- d. Subparagraph F of the Order paragraph is amended to read, "The first quarterly report required by this Order is due not later than October, 30, 2006, and should cover the period for the third calendar quarter, from July, 2006 through September, 2006."

All other terms and conditions in Order 2229 remain in full force and effect.
