ORDER VACATING BLANKET AUTHORIZATION TO IMPORT NATURAL GAS FROM CANADA

DOE/FE ORDER NO. 2576-A

On October 22, 2008 the Office of Fossil Energy (FE) of the Department of Energy (DOE) granted blanket authorization to Trilogy Energy L.P. (Trilogy) in DOE/FE Order No. 2576 (Order 2576) to import up to a total of 15 billion cubic feet of natural gas from Canada over a two-year term beginning on October 22, 2008, and extending through October 21, 2010.¹

On November 20, 2008, Trilogy notified DOE that it no longer needs its current authorization due to unresolved legal issues affecting the requested application to import natural gas and subsequently issued authorization. Trilogy is no longer importing natural gas from Canada therefore, the import authorization is no longer needed. Trilogy requests that DOE vacate Order 2576, effective the date of this Order.
